Rules & Regulations

1. Each participating department is to be represented by five individual participants. No teams will be constructed and activity will be carried as individual competition.
2. Participants will submit the recorded video of their debate within due deadline (22-07-2021), which will be evaluated by the jury members.
3. A speaker may agree or disagree with the topic. The subject matter of the speech based on the logical interpretation of the topic will carry maximum credit in terms of marks.
4. Content from social media is not allowed.
5. A speaker will speak for a minimum of 3 minutes and maximum of 5 minutes.
6. A speaker making offensive remarks about any important personage or passing controversial religious, political or sectarian remarks shall be immediately disqualified.
7. The speakers will be judged on the content of their speeches, their proficiency of respective language and the body gestures.
8. Paper reading is not allowed. Those who do so will be disqualified.
9. Speakers should refrain from using excessive Urdu in their English speeches and vice versa.
10. The decision of the judges will be final.
