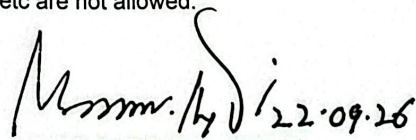

The examination will be designed to ascertain whether the candidates have attained the breadth of knowledge and the intellectual maturity necessary to become a successful scholar in the chosen discipline. This will not be mere re-examination of previous course(s) work but will be designed so as to test the ability to integrate and assimilate the knowledge obtained from the courses, seminars and independent studies. To pass the written comprehensive examination, a student must obtain at least **65%** marks separately in each paper.
